

**FAIRFAX COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD  
BOND REFERENDUM RESOLUTION**

April 23, 2009

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF FAIRFAX COUNTY, VIRGINIA, TO ASK THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY TO ORDER AN ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF CONTRACTING A DEBT, BORROWING MONEY AND ISSUING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS OF THE COUNTY IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$232,580,000 FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROVIDING FUNDS, WITH ANY OTHER AVAILABLE FUNDS, TO FINANCE THE COSTS OF IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE SCHOOL SYSTEM.**

**WHEREAS**, the Fairfax County School Board of Fairfax County, Virginia, has determined that certain school improvements should be financed including acquiring, building, expanding and renovating properties, including new sites, new buildings or additions, renovations and improvements to existing buildings, and furnishings and equipment, for the Fairfax County public school system; and

**WHEREAS**, the School Board has determined that, for the purpose of providing funds to pay the cost of such public school improvements and the cost of such public school property, Fairfax County should contract a debt, borrow money and issue bonds in the aggregate principal amount of \$232,580,000; and

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the School Board that:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of Fairfax County, Virginia, is hereby requested to ask the Circuit Court of Fairfax County, Virginia, to order an election on the question of contracting a debt, borrowing money, and issuing capital improvement bonds of Fairfax County, Virginia in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$232,580,000 for the purposes of providing funds, in addition to funds from school bonds previously authorized and any other available funds, to finance, including reimbursement to the County for temporary financing for, the costs of school improvements, including acquiring, building, expanding and renovating properties, including new sites, new buildings or additions, renovations and improvements to existing buildings, and furnishings and equipment, for the Fairfax County public school system.

Section 2. The Board of Supervisors is hereby advised that it is the desire of the School Board that the proposed referendum be scheduled for November 3, 2009.

Section 3. The Clerk of the School Board is hereby authorized and directed to file two certified copies of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors of Fairfax County, Virginia.
