A student may request a student transfer for the Global STEM Challenges Program at Edison High School. The initial student transfer request for this purpose is for students entering grade 9.

1. A student who requests a transfer for the Global STEM Challenges Program at Edison High School must commit to the program for grades 9, 10, and 11:
 - a. Each student is expected to pursue the three designated courses for the Global STEM Challenges Program in grades 9, 10, and 11.
 - b. Pursuing the full International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma is not a requirement for the Global STEM Challenges Program. However, if your student is planning on completing the full IB Diploma, he or she must meet with the IB Coordinator at Edison High School to develop a four-year academic plan. The academic plan must be submitted as documentation with the application.

2. Transportation will NOT be provided for student transfers for the Global STEM Challenges Program at Edison High School.
3. Parents and students are encouraged to attend a Global STEM Challenges information session sponsored by Edison High School or the school division.
4. The opportunity for student transfers for the Global STEM Challenges Program is limited, based on availability. Students and parents will accept the decision to deny admission due to lack of space available at Edison High School.
5. Students are expected to maintain appropriate behavior, attend school regularly, and demonstrate academic progress.
6. A student who does not fulfill the aforementioned expectations will be required to return to his or her base school.
7. Parents and students must complete and return the new high school curricular student transfer application (available at <https://www.fcps.edu/sites/default/files/media/forms/se221.pdf>) to the student's base high school with a signed copy of this letter of understanding. Note: With this attached form, the reason "Global STEM Challenges Program" should be written in as the reason for the student transfer request. Forms for the Global STEM Challenges Program only will be accepted until June 15. All other requests will follow the established timeline for student transfer requests.
8. Renewal applications must be submitted annually. Parents and students must complete and return the renewal student transfer application (available at <http://www.fcps.edu/sites/default/files/media/forms/se223.pdf>) to the student's current high school with a signed copy of this letter of understanding. Forms will be accepted at the requested school beginning February 15 and will not be accepted after April 1.
