 Capital Programs, which includes capital planning, sustainability, utilities, grounds
 related upkeep, and facility maintenance.
- Jessica Gillis, Executive Director for Facilities and Transportation Services
 - New FPAC Charge: discussed how can Jessica, Janice, COO staff help with charge items
 - Switch Gear continue to be long lead items. Falls Church High School switch gear came at the end of the summer. Supply Chain and labor shortage have caused project delays.
 - o Bonnie Brae ES bid opening delayed until October in case of lower inflation
 - Bond referendum vote this year anti and pro-bond group meetings are being supported by Jessica and staff
 - Brookfield Elementary School project continues and we will continue to be tracked by FPAC
 - o CIP is in development
 - 2 boundary changes underway Kent Gardens options will be presented to community this month; Glasgow – second scoping meeting: reducing numbers in enrollment due to large population of students approximately 1,800 assigned to school
 - Renovation Queue: Staff met with DLR group recently; recommendations were paused to wait for Strategic Plan to be completed which is now complete. Facility condition assessments will be contracted out; scope still needs to be developed. Results from facility condition assessments will provide data as one part of the renovation queue formulation. Another part of this renovation queue should incorporate input from community users of FCPS facilities.
 - Condition Assessment for the City of Fairfax schools is complete: lessons learned, what was considered, etc. should be reviewed.
 - Next Step for renovation queue:
 - FPAC may be asked to Comment on DLR Renovation Criteria
 - DLR is on contract to develop renovation queue. Will fold in the strategic plan.
 - Need to determine what key points in time and how/when will FPAC be valuable to the Renovation Queue development
 - There is a push by the School Board to determine the roles of CPDC and FPAC and how they differ and how they are related.
- Takeaways from FPAC Annual Report presentation identified by Katie for discussion with FPAC and staff. Two possible Annual Charge items were:
 - 1) Pre-K classrooms in FCPS was a topic of interest expressed by the School Board that FPAC could explore.
 - 2) Boundary policy was also important to the School Board; there is interest from the Superintendent to look at more boundary changes; administrative boundary changes (simple changes for unoccupied developments). Current policy – previous superintendent put moratorium on administrative boundary changes (in 2018). The

School Board would like to revisit this policy implementation. Recommended Draft revision language policy for boundary changes is ready for Board review.

Melissa Morrison, a concerned parent of Herndon High School and Herndon Middle School students, was in attendance and addressed FPAC primarily about concerns for the conditions of the facilities and grounds of Herndon Middle School. She highlighted examples of poor conditions in the school building and the soccer and baseball fields.

Ms. Morrison noted significant academic gaps at Herndon Middle School and described that the school is not meeting standards and demonstrates large performance gaps compared to the nearest school.

Ms. Morrison is looking for support to improve facilities at Herndon Middle School and notes that 2031 is not soon enough for facility renovations. Additionally, she discussed safety concerns related to the area adjacent to the soccer fields.
