C19 Overview


Students with disabilities* are entitled to a free appropriate public education (FAPE) and may require compensatory education to remedy any educational or other deficits that resulted when a student with an individualized education program (IEP) or Section 504 Plan did not receive the regular or special education, and/or related services designed to meet their individual educational needs during the Pandemic Period (April 14, 2020 - June 10, 2022).

*This term includes students who have IEPs and and those who have 504 Plans




C19 Overview Cont...

C19 compensatory education services are for students with disabilities who did not receive the regular or special education and/or related aids/services designed to meet their individual educational needs during the Pandemic Period



Who is Eligible

Students with an individualized education program (IEP) or Section 504 Plan who did not receive the regular or special education, and/or related services designed to meet their individual educational needs during the Pandemic Period (April 14, 2020 - June 10, 2022) and who have C19 compensatory education services indicated on their IEP.

How to Access Services

1. Contact the OCR Plan Administrator to connect you with Varsity Tutors for Schools
 2. The Varsity Tutors for Schools Team will reach out to you by phone call and/or email to help you get started. You will have a 5-10 minute consultation call with a Parent Engagement Coordinator, who will learn more about your student's specific learning needs and help you schedule recurring tutoring sessions.
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Scheduling

Schedule weekly tutoring sessions on the days and times that work for your student's schedule, making it easy to fit tutoring into your family's routine. You can make changes to your scheduled sessions up to 24 hours in advance of your student's scheduled session time.
